

**2021 California Envirothon (CAE)  
Final Registration Form: May 22 and 29, 2021 Virtual Events  
“Water Resources Management: Local Control and Local Solutions”**

**The final registration form and registration fee must be submitted by May 3, 2021.** As the 2021 competition is virtual, fees are reduced to: \$75 per team (i.e., five students); \$15/teacher; \$15 alternate.

To guarantee anonymity during judging, each team is asked to create a name to identify itself (not school related). Examples in the past have included wildlife, mythological figures, constellations, soil types, etc. (e.g., The Wolves, The Oaks, Ursa Major Daphne, Sandy Loam, etc.).

Please review the February 2021 update of the **CAE Operating Rules and Regulations**. It is posted on the CAE website (caenvirothon.com) under the tab “About Us.” Please check the box below to certify that you and the students have done so and fully understand how the event is conducted and operated. The rules are organized in three sections: **I. Team Eligibility Requirements; II. Competition Rules and Regulations; and III. Codes of Conduct**. You have until the final registration deadline to provide the certification.

One important rule is that no more than two teams from a school shall be designated to officially compete. Each team is encouraged to have one alternate. If any school wishes to include more than two teams, it is with the understanding that these extra teams are not allowed to advance in the competition. Any additional teams, or a team formed by alternates from among participating schools, shall do so for the CAE experience. Only one team per school may advance to finals.

CAE also welcomes student teams from non-traditional schools, youth organizations, or nonprofits such as 4-H and FFA.

CAE is a special project of the California Association of Resource Conservation Districts. RCDs often provide support and sponsorship to local school teams. To find your local RCD, go to the website, [carcd.org](http://carcd.org), and click on the tab “RCDs” to access the regional RCD network. Don't hesitate to reach out to the local RCD for assistance and support, and to make them aware of your participation in CAE.
