The **final registration form** must be received by **March 12**. Please submit form to Jovita Pajarillo, Chair, CAE (jovita@schenkerdesign.com).

The registration fee for the 2022 CAE virtual event is \$15.00 per student and teacher/advisor (i.e., \$75/team). If the team has an alternate(s) (no more than two) the fee is \$15 for each. Fees must be submitted by March 12. Please make checks payable to “California Envirothon” and mail registration fees to Marianne Maki, CAE Treasurer, 3809 Cresta Court, Thousand Oaks, CA 91361.

We now require sign off from the school’s principal or vice principal indicating approval for the students’ participation in CAE (see the top of page two).

For those schools who have pre-registered, if there are no changes among your team members, you only need to submit this cover form with the school’s signed sanction.

We are very disappointed to once again not have an in-person event this year and know you all understand the reasons why. As in 2021’s virtual event, it will be via Zoom: March 26 will be devoted to station testing and April 2 for preliminary and final orals presentations, a panel of natural resources professionals, and award ceremonies.

Important Information and Instructions (based on the CAE Operating Rules and Regulations)

1. To guarantee anonymity during judging, each team is asked to create a name for identification and it must not be related to their school. Examples in the past have included soil types, flora and fauna, water or geological features such as The Wolves, The Oaks, Sandy Loam, Green Ravens, Aquifers, etc.
2. No more than two teams from a school is designated to officially compete. Each team is encouraged to have an alternate. If any school wishes to include more than two teams, it is with understanding that the additional team(s) are not officially recognized and are participating for the experience of the CAE competition (see CAE Operating Rules and Regulations, Section I. Team Eligibility Requirements, #10). Teachers and advisors must make this clear to the additional team(s) and their members to avoid confusion and disappointment. Please note your official teams.
3. Only one team per school advances to the finals.
4. Please let us know if any of your senior students have competed in the CAE for all four years of high school. They will receive a special award at the end of the competition.
5. Designate which student is the team captain on the registration form.
6. We will require a “Photograph and Video Release Form” by March 17. You will receive the form by March 12. It will allow us to use recorded video of the event for CAE promotional use.

The CAE Operating Rules and Regulations were updated on September 2, 2021. Please note new rules have been added to address team eligibility requirements and oral presentations (extended to 20 minutes from 15 minutes). Other changes were for clarity and streamlining.
