Registration fees are \$250/team or \$50/person. If there is more than one team from a high school or youth organization, the fees shall apply accordingly. **Fees are due no later than March 12**. A final registration form will be sent out on February 21 and must be submitted by March 12. This will confirm each school's number of teams, participating students (including alternates), teacher advisors, and chaperones.
